	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Documents and further information in the case of not-for-profit organizations● The missions and objectives of the organization which request for short codes must be beneficial to the public interest with the obvious information shown.● The mission above must clearly demonstrate that there is an urgent need for short codes.● The current volume of telephone numbers used for fixed phone services or other communication channels must clearly show that there are many limitations in the process.● Estimated revenue and expenditure, and sources of annual revenue● Service area indication to provide nationwide coverage. In concern with limitation area, proposal of short codes utilization sharing with other agency will be taking into consideration.
